

Fair Book Changes Summary

1. ✓ Change age groups across all 4-H & Open Class departments to Junior Age 7-8; Intermediate Age 9-13; Senior Age 14-18. This matches Kansas State Fair age groups.
2. ✓ Shooting Sports – created own department, reference Kansas State Fair rules
3. ✓ Open Class Garden: Add Class Number: 11191 Class Description: Theme Garden Pots (Limit of 1)
4. ✓ 4-H Garden: Add Class Number: 41842 Class Description: Theme Garden Pots (Limit of 1)
5. ✓ 4-H Style Revue – Constructed Garments: Increase limit to 2 on all classes
6. ✓ Open Class Poultry Showmanship: Classes added, add to fair book, ribbons
7. ✓ Open Class Rabbit Showmanship: Classes added, add to fair book, ribbons
8. ✓ 4-H & Open Class Foods: Added no alcohol or illegal drugs to be used in food.
9. ✓ 4-H & Open Class Foods: Changed quantity on items to 3 (i.e. 3 cookies, 3 muffins, etc.).
10. ✓ 4-H & Open Class Foods: Added nut (pecan) pies are acceptable.
11. ✓ 4-H Foods: Added food gift package needs to be for human consumption.
12. ✓ 4-H Style Revue: 60% of a garment must be made to be considered a constructed garment.
13. ✓ Round Robin: Each species, judging, and judge comments will last no more than 10 minutes (7 minutes with 3 minutes of judge comments).
14. ✓ 4-H & Open Class Breeding Goat: Remove Horns should be tipped and rounded.
15. ✓ 4-H & Open Class Livestock: Weigh-in from 8:00 – 10:00 am.
16. ✓ Open Class: Every exhibit (youth and adult) will be judged and award either a blue, red, or white ribbon. Class champion and reserve class champion will only be used at the discretion of the superintendent and the judge when necessary. If there are limited number of exhibits in a class, they may be combined with other classes at the discretion of the superintendent and the judge. Grand champion and reserve grand champion will be award in a “best of show” style.
