1. ✓ Open Class & 4-H General Rules: There is a universal release time from 7:30 - 9:00 a.m. on the final Saturday of fair. All articles must be claimed by 9:00 a.m. The Extension Office and Fair Board will not be held responsible for picking up articles not claimed.
2. ✓ Open Class Crafts: Moved ceramics class from arts to crafts.
3. ✓ Open Class Bucket Calf: This project is for exhibitors 12 and under. Exhibitor must not have passed their 12th birthday by 1-1 of the current year.
4. ✓ 4-H Shooting Sports: Added to entry and judging schedule
5. ✓ 4-H Shooting Sports: Added superintendent
6. ✓ 4-H Food: Combined decorated foods into once class – 41603: Age 7-18 - Decorated Food Item (Limit of 1)
7. ✓ 4-H Food: Added Grand Champion Decorated Food Item Award
8. ✓ 4-H Food: Added Reserve Grand Champion Decorated Food Item Award
9. ✓ 4-H Food: Removed Class Champion Decorated Food Item

13. ✓ 4-H Livestock: No livestock in barns before 8:00 a.m. Monday of fair. All animals (including poultry and rabbits) should be stalled by 7:00 a.m. Tuesday of fair. All animals (marketing, breeding, dairy) need to remain in the barn until at least Friday 12:00 noon at the end of fair. If an animal needs to leave early for whatever reason the decision must be approved unanimously by the superintendent, fair board, and the extension office.
14. ✓ Open Class & 4-H Livestock: Northwest Kansas District Free Fair board is not responsible for lost or injured animals that are taken outside of the livestock barns' perimeter fence anytime during the fair. Encouraged to keep animals properly stalled. If it is necessary to exiting the perimeter animals must be properly controlled.
15. ✓ Open Class & 4-H Livestock Goat: No bucks of any age will be allowed on the grounds. Only does and wethers can show.
16. ✓ 4-H Round Robin Showmanship: Participants must ask for permission before working with someone else's animal or equipment prior to the show.
